INDOOR PLANTING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS





NOTE: Plant as soon as possible after purchase. If not planting immediately, store in a cool, dry place with plenty of air circulation.

TIPS

- If the bulb has already started growing, plant it immediately. Otherwise, store in a cool, dry place until ready to plant.
- Spread some pebbles or marbles over the planting mix for a polished effect.
- Turn the pot regularly to ensure the stem grows straight.
- Plant multiple kits in two-week intervals for continuous floral color during the holidays.

Amaryllis Indoor Planting Instructions

- Fill a planter container 1/3 with moist, well-drained soil.
- Place the Amaryllis bulb in the soil with roots facing down.
- 3 Add additional soil around the bulb. 1/3 of the bulb should remain above the surface.
- Keep the planter in a bright room at a minimum temperature range of 65-70° F.
- Keep the soil moist, not wet.
- Keep blooming flowers out of direct sunlight to prolong blossoms.



After Care

When blooms fade, cut off the tubular flower stems near the top of the bulb, leaving the foliage to continue growing. Water as usual and apply a water-soluble fertilizer every four weeks. After the danger of frost has passed, place your Amaryllis pot outside to enjoy the summer sun. Continue to fertilize every four weeks, which is necessary for the next season of blooms. Bring your Amaryllis inside after summer and allow the bulb to dry out completely in a cool, dry place. Repot your Amaryllis in fresh soil and start the cycle all over again!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS





A. An amaryllis typically takes about 7 to 10 weeks to bloom after planting.

Where is the best place to put Amaryllis to grow indoors?

A. Place the amaryllis in a space where it can bask in abundant natural sunlight and warmth. As growth starts, remember to give the pot a gentle rotation every few days. This practice will help promote the development of upright flower stalks. Once the bulb is flowering, relocate the plant away from direct sunlight.

• How do you store Amaryllis bulbs before planting?

A. Plant Amaryllis bulbs soon after purchase, but if you need to wait, store them in a cool, dry, dark place—avoid refrigeration.
