Soil Preparation

**Great gardens start with great soil!
Soil preparation is essential for successful gardening.**

Healthy soil should have good tilth, nutrient content, and a viable population of beneficial microorganisms. We recommend using natural and organic ingredients to prepare the soil and maintain soil fertility. It is always a good idea to have a soil test to identify your soil type (sandy, loam, silt, clay) and find out your soil pH.

NOTE: It is important to store correctly until planting. Store in a cool, dry place with plenty of air circulation. Plant in spring as soon as ground has thawed and soil has warmed to 50°F and is workable. Usually 4-6 weeks after the last frost.

Caladium Planting Instructions

- 1 Select a well-drained location that receives full shade to partial sun. Before planting, soil temperature needs to be at a minimum of 65°F.
- 2 Loosen soil and dig a hole a little deeper than the indicated depth.
- 3 Plant Caladium bulbs so the top of the bulb is about 2" below the soil surface and each bulb about 5-6" apart. Place bulb with the roots facing down and any sprouts facing up.
- 4 After planting, water well so that the soil above the bulbs settles. Keep soil moist during periods of dry weather but do not overwater.



About Caladiums

Garden State Bulb Carolyn Whorton Pink Caladium Bare Roots are sourced from farms and growers in the US. Each bare root is hand picked and inspected for quality before shipment. The Carolyn Whorton' (Angel Wings) is a stunning tuberous perennial that is highly valued for its vibrant and colorful leaves. The large, heart-shaped leaves are a beautiful shade of pink, with intricate red veining and dark green edges. Although the flowers are small and inconspicuous, resembling calla lilies, they often go unnoticed as they are hidden beneath the lush foliage. This particular variety of Caladium is known for its resilience and can tolerate more sunlight than other Caladiums, making it a versatile choice for both outdoor borders and containers. Additionally, its stunning appearance makes it a perfect choice for indoor decoration, as it also thrives as a houseplant!

A. Spring planted/summer blooming bulbs and tubers can be planted in the spring when you are certain the ground will no longer freeze in your area.

Q. What should I plant with caladiums?

A. Other spring planted/summer blooming bulbs to plant with caladiums include dahlias, gladioli, calla lilies, and more!

Q. What is the best way to store my bulbs until I plant them?

A. Store bulbs in a cool, dark, and dry spot with good air circulation prior to planting them.
